That was the first time they landed here, about two years ago. But Steve worked hard, found a good job and was able to save up for an apartment. They were on their own and feeling hopeful again.

Then, Steve and Shawna got the news no parent should ever have to receive. Their son in Colorado had committed suicide. Steve's company seemed understanding, telling him to take the time he needed to bury his son.

Just a few days later, he returned and was informed that they were letting him go for missing work. Still reeling from his tragic loss, Steve was jobless once again. They lost the apartment, and found themselves right back at Crossroads.

"I don't know what we'd do without this place," Steve says. He's able to have safe shelter and food while he works to get back on his feet. He's gotten his
